WHAT LIVING WELL IS

The first priority of Living Well is to help individuals to build their relationship with the Father as revealed through Jesus. In union with Him, we develop a deep understanding of His love for us.

Living Well is a self-examination, based on the prayer of David, that invites the Holy Spirit to examine one's heart in light of holy scripture. At its core, the program is aimed at persons struggling with a broken aspect of their sexual and relational identity and who yearn to be free from its domination.

A primary goal of Living Well is to help individuals to discover the loving, powerful presence of the God who is there on behalf of their struggle. Embracing His love in the roots, the compulsions, the perceptions and relationships that make up that struggle is the key to freedom from sexual and relational brokenness. This also brings freedom to mature in healthy relationships in everyday life. It is a dedicated time to examine and apply the truth of scripture to the wounds of one's spirit, soul and body. It is an intentional invitation for the healing of our true identity as children of God, embracing all the Father has for us as followers of Jesus.
